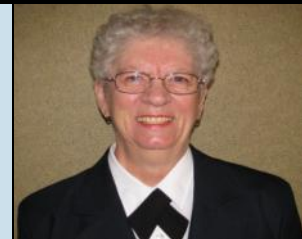
P/C Lance VandeBerg, P, has accepted to continue as Chair of the Vessel Safety Check Program.

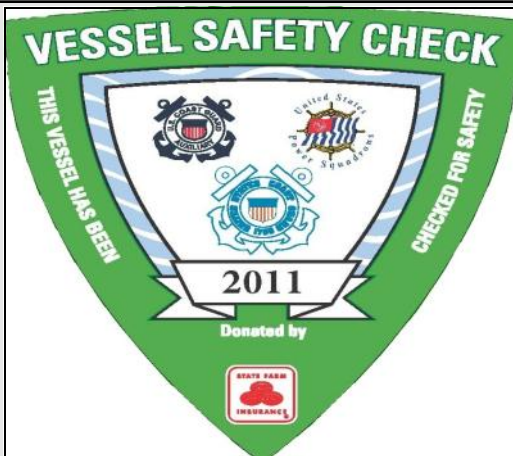

## March Boating Report, P/C Duane L. Balkema, AP

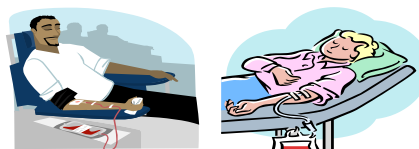
