

Boats & Boating Report P/C Duane L. Balkema, AP

November 14th, Sunday, 1:00 PM is our arrival time for "Rendezvous at Samson Island on Grand Canal". The city of Satellite Beach (773-6458) offers a pontoon boat ride over to this very interesting "Nature" Island at 1:00 PM & return and there are docks as well for personal craft. P/C Bud Miller, JN and I organized many a trip to this beautiful island in our Brevard County. Call me at 321-452-5892 if interested in coming to this event.

Wednesday, November 17th at 11:30 we have arranged for Mark & Michelle Andersons, Blue Dolphin to take us for a "Nature Cruise" boat ride for \$20 plus \$4 additional if desired to have a Sub Sandwich & salad. Departure is from Kelly Park Dock just off Hwy 528 at North Banana River Drive, Merritt Island. A drink is provided, the boat is covered protecting you from the sun and there is a toilet. Boat Report 2--My Sea Ray 31 Foot Sedan Bridge Economy Project Cost reduction is my project with a SRV 310 of 1982 Sea Ray Flybridge vintage. Last Month I outlined what I was doing, by taking out the V8s and installing 4 cylinder engines. Several questioned how I did this myself. To answer, I would call it half and half. I towed the boat to Banana River Marine with the engines unhooked and ready to lift out. They lifted each 1200# V8 and sat them on my utility trailer. I towed the boat back to my dock. At dock, I used a 2 x 12 x 12 foot slant board and slid each assembled with crankshaft and pistons 4-cylinder engine block weighing around 150 # down into its place. I wedged and pried them into position and bolted the mounts to the engine beds. Then I proceeded to build up the engines with cylinder heads, manifolds, etc. in place until complete and hooked up. With new piston rings and bearings the engines run well.




