Well, it's Holiday time again, and the last SEO report for calendar 2012. A little review of the Education Department accomplishments is in order:

We did 3 ABC3 classes and 24 Students earned their Florida licenses. This generated 20 or so new CBSPS members. Welcome to our new members once again. It is our hope that you take full advantage of all the activities and continue your boating education.

A Boating Safety presentation day was done at Edgewood High School with over 700 students attending.

Five classes were taught by our knowledgeable Instructors to 45 members, including 5 from other squadrons. This should result by year-end in 4 new Education Proficiency levels and one Education Achievement level for a squadron total of 36 and 20, respectively.

CBSPS received the District 23 Education Proficiency award at the 2012 Fall Conference. Since its inception in 1991, CBSPS has received this award 9 times out of 22 years, more than any other squadron in our district. You can help us keep this up by taking the next AP course starting 14 January at BVMC and/or that missing 3rd Elective.

All in all, not too shabby! We could even say "Pretty Darn Good!!"

But we intend to do even better in 2013 with, not only, 4 ABC3 classes and probably one high school Boating Safety presentation, but also, the introduction of the Boat Operator Certification (BOC) program in Brevard County. Four members have already signed up for their "Passports" toward achieving the IN (Inland Navigation) level. This is a program of courses, seminars and demonstrations, all of which will be offered next year by your friendly squadron. So come and join us in this new education adventure.

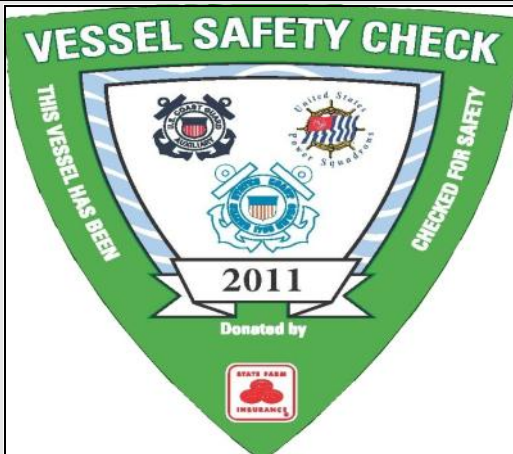
Boating Report by P/C Duane L. Balkema, AP

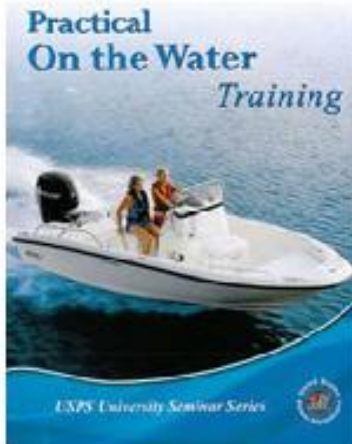

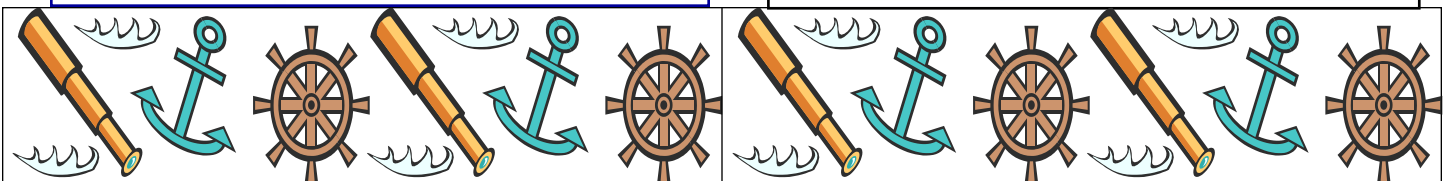
