

All year long we have to listen to the exhortations to focus on our mission and goals, not to take our eye off the ball and so on. Not this time and not from me – at least for a short period. The time has come when we need to stop for a look back to determine what we have accomplished and put together the Historian's Report - what we have not accomplished makes for a good start with renewed enthusiasm as next year's goal.

Anyway, what is the Historian's Report? It is compilation of who in the squadron accomplished what between Changes of Watch. It is due within 30 days following the end of your Change of Watch – plenty of time to get your ducks in a row. You, the Squadron Secretaries can go about this in two ways:

Open DB2000, go to *Forms* and click on *Historian's Form* and start filling in the information that you have been collecting so diligently since your last COW. If diligence went missing, like in my case, it helps to go to:

<u>www.usps.org</u> click on *Site Index* (upper right), then *Forms* and on the left hand bar open *Historians* and print the *Squadron Historian's Form*. Pages 1 and 2 are easy, just copy from your Directory. Page 3 (Section V) is even easier – delegate it to your SEO (don't forget to give him/her a deadline if you want results). Delegate Sections VI and VII to the rest of the Bridge (you may have to include yourself and don't forget deadlines).

Once you have all the required info you go back to DB2000 fill in the blanks and submit it via web site. If you want to complicate my life (don't expect quick forgiveness) then fill out the six-page report and mail two copies to me.

Seriously, it is important that we recognize and document the work that is being accomplished by so many volunteers, without them we would not amount to much

Boating Committee Report P/C Duane L. Balkema, AP

Our Treasure Hunt in the canals of Cocoa Beach was successfully held on a beautiful windy day. Note the pictures showing some of the folks. Chuck Conklin's boat with crew, John Mulkey and Joe Auchter identified the most "Clues" from the list. Thanks to all, the above plus Pam & Randy Johnson, Jay & Donna Longway, Kermit Forbes, Lance Vandeberg and Margie and myself.

October 30th we will Raft-Up and watch the Cocoa Beach Air Show, starting at 1:00 PM. Titusville again has this on their schedule. Call me early if planning on this one. Depending on boat sizes & weather, we can raft up inside or outside to view.

Boat Report--My Sea Ray 31 Foot Sedan Bridge Project As known, Boats are very expensive and difficult to maintain and operate. Cost reduction is my project with a SRV 310 of 1982 Sea Ray Flybridge vintage. Some may find this project interesting as it moves along. Briefly, Sea Ray (Merritt Island Plant) built my boat with two 340 HP Mercruisers (actually 454 cubic inch Chevrolets commonly called Big Blocks) and two 120 gallon fuel tanks. Both engines I removed and one fuel tank. This boat came equipped with nearly every option. Obviously every electronic device was old (some had been replaced) and was removed plus some old interior pieces. Think of the weight removed, considering that the V8 engines each had 2 manifolds and consider you could not see the spark plugs as they were way under the manifolds. Estimated engine complete weight was 1200# x 2. Fuel consumption was big when run at even moderate power.

The idea is that a pontoon boat with a Mercruiser 3.0 can run all afternoon at low and high speeds on 15 gallons of gas. Why not fool the Sea Ray and put two Mercruiser 3.0's in it and run all day on 30 gallons of gas. So far I have not burned 30 gallons of fuel in an afternoon, not near it. The changes are made and the boat is running, it is an estimated 2000# lighter and you can see the 8 total-not 16 as before-spark plugs for maintenance. It does not need a fuel tanker every 5 hours. Current work is in finding the right size prop for the SB engine. It's on the way via Ebay as I write this. As a side note; "e-gads" there is not a high prices hard to repair computer on the engines and you can change the points for under \$20. More to follow on this project.




