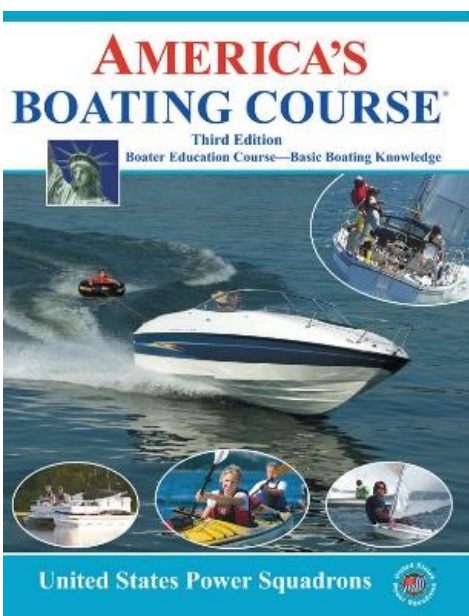
Education News:

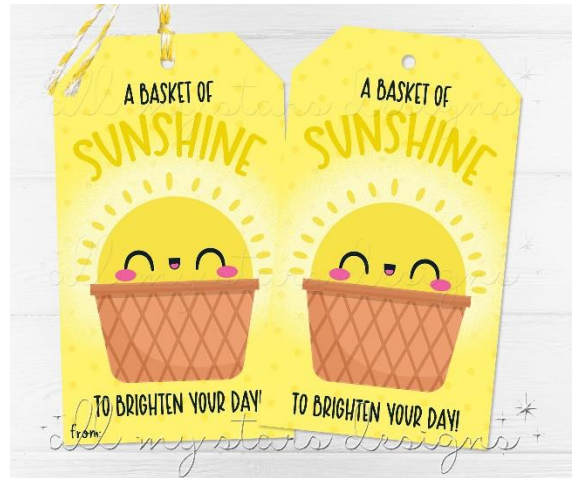
