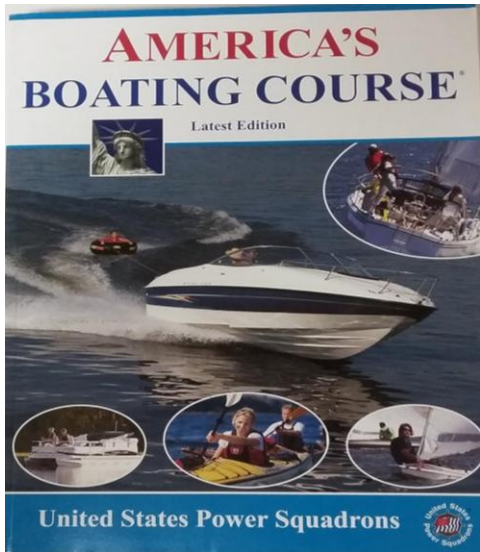

BOATING EDUCATION COURSE



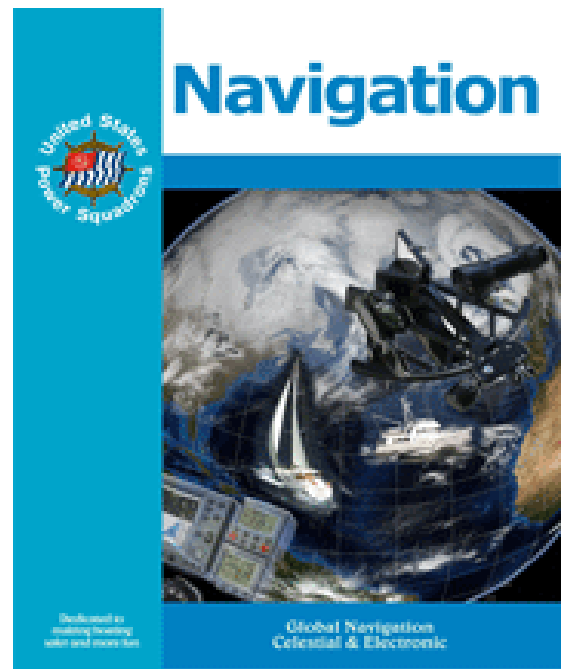

SEPTEMBER NOT-BOAT BUT ROAD RALLY EVENT September 12, 2025

RULE 1: We will meet at the JC Penny parking lot on the east side of JC Penny near the road at 11:10 on September 12, 2025

RULE 2: The cost is \$10.00 per person to cover cost and prizes. I will need to know how many people are going to be in your car and if they are currently a member so I do not double count them if they signed up as well. I need this information to inform the restaurant of a final count for lunch

RULE 3: Each person will be required to sign a release form to participate in the road rally.

RULE 4: The road rally will be like last year's event with clues to get from site to site. You will solve a parking lot clue and be told what site to drive to. Once you arrive you will receive an envelope with a clue to the next site. You will have time to sit and have a refreshment and appetizer while you solve the clue to the next site. If you spend more than 20 minutes trying to solve the clue, open the emergency envelope for that site. It will give you the answer and you will be off to the next site.

RULE 5: You will receive a bag at the parking lot with items that may help you solve a clue or statements that may help you solve a clue. You will also be given emergency envelope for each site if you need them. You will have a list of approximately 15 sites but only 5 are real. The answer to each site will have a corresponding answer on the site sheet.

RULE 6: Also in the bag there will be an envelope with a clue to the restaurant and an emergency envelope if you have difficulty solving the restaurant clue.

RULE 7: Please try to arrive at the restaurant by 3:00pm.

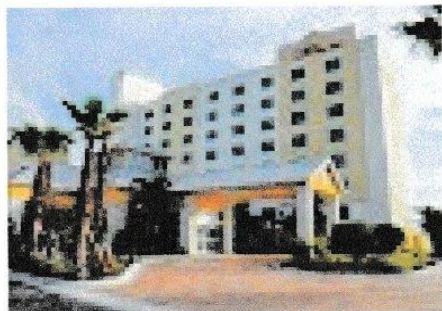
