## Cruise to Captain Hiram's





Join the crew at Captain Hiram's. It may be too late to book a room at the discount price but boat slips should still be available.

### Education Update:


- While classes are delayed until fall, SEO Mike Haney is looking for students for Cruising and Cruise Planning and/or Marine Radio Communications

- The board extends its gratitude to her for all her hard work and looks forward to seeing her at meetings and on the water.




## Member at Large Resignation:


